## **Registration Fees**

## **Online Registration**

You will need an online account at <https://bchda.wildapricot.org/>. Please create an online account by selecting Guest Account at <https://bchda.wildapricot.org/Join-Us>

1. Click on Events in the top menu, and register for 2022 BC Games Competition Online Registration.
2. When you register for the event it will ask for all the dancer's info. Please fill out all the information correctly.
3. If you have MORE than one dancer, on the Review and Confirm page, you can select "Invoice Me", and then register another dancer. Once finished, select "Pay Online".

## **Covid Safety & Protocols**

1. Public Health requirements will be continuously evaluated, and participants will be informed of any Covid-19 protocols prior to the event through social media and email.
2. In the absence of any Public Health Order mandates, the organizing committee for the BC Highland Games & Scottish Festival Highland Dance Competition strongly encourage participants to:
  - a. Wear a mask for your own protection and the protection of others (dancers continue to have a choice whether to wear a mask while competing)
  - b. Maintain physical distancing wherever possible
  - c. Frequent hand hygiene
  - d. Stay home if you feel sick

3. Upon registering for this event and immediately prior to the event, you agree to the requirements and recommendations of any National, Provincial and local Public health and other governmental authorities as well as any requirements from Town Centre Park/City of Coquitlam which may be in effect at the time of the event, as it pertains to the Covid-19 Coronavirus and to adopt all necessary measures to those effects.
4. Participants are required to agree to each of the following at the time of registration:
  - a. Good Health Declaration
  - b. Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability Relating to Coronavirus/Covid-19
  - c. ScotDance Canada Competition and Workshop Waiver

## Rules & Regulations

1. The City of Vancouver Championship is recognized by the RSOBHD. The Rules and Regulations of the RSOBHD will govern all dancing events.
2. This event may be cancelled at any time up to, and including on or during the date of competition, dependent upon public health concerns.
3. The decision of the judge(s) is final.
4. When all entries are received, the Association will determine the breakdown of classes and reserve the right to divide, combine or delete/cancel classes where necessary.
5. All Championship participants must dance the 2022 RSOBHD set steps. Six placings will be awarded in all Championship events.
6. Dancers will compete in reverse order of entry for ALL events, including Championship events. First to enter will be last to dance.
7. Any dancer not ready when called shall forfeit entry in that event. Dancers must fill in for Reels as requested.
8. Dancers must be registered with the RSOBHD or RSOBHD subsidiary body (such as
9. ScotDance Canada) in order to compete. All competitors must present current RSOBHD registration card prior to receiving awards. A \$ 10.00 administration fee is charged for forgotten cards.
10. Protests must be made in writing, signed and submitted to the Organiser by the end of the competition day and must be accompanied by a \$35.00 fee, refundable, if sustained.
11. Dancer must appear in costume for presentation of awards and photographs.
12. Age for entry for all events will be as of June 18, 2022.
13. Competition Secretary must be advised of Category changes by email at [bchda.competitionsecretary@gmail.com](mailto:bchda.competitionsecretary@gmail.com) by June 11, 2022
14. Entry fee must accompany registration.
15. No refund will be given. Where admittance to event is refused based upon good health declaration, fees will be refunded (excepting an administration fee of \$5.00 per family)
16. Dancers must be dressed appropriately at all times.
17. Dancers and parents must respect the ScotDance Canada Risk Management Guidelines, local, Provincial and Federal health authority directives, and RSOBHD Code of Ethics.

## **ScotDance Canada Competition and Workshop Waiver**

I am aware that participating in the the BC Highland Games & Scottish Festival Highland Dance Competition involves the potential for risks, dangers and hazards, including but not limited to:

(a) injury to myself / my child as a result of the physical nature of dance competition and performance; and

(b) the taking and/or release of unauthorized photographs, video and/or other recordings of myself and/or my child, notwithstanding efforts to enforce Event policies.

In consideration of my / my child's participation in the Event and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged, I hereby WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS against ScotDance Canada, its directors, agents, employees, executive members, volunteers and organizers of the Event (the "Releasees"), which I now have, or hereafter may have against the Releasees. In particular, but without limiting the foregoing, I agree to release the Releasees from ANY AND ALL LIABILITY for any loss, damage, injury, or expense I / my child may incur as a result of my / my child's participation in or attendance at the Event. I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Releasees from ANY LOSS, DAMAGE, INJURY OR EXPENSE, including legal costs, that the Releasees may incur due to my / my child's participation in or attendance at the Event, whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise, and whether caused to my child or otherwise. I understand that the Releaseees will photograph and otherwise record the Event, its participants and attendees. I consent to and authorize such recording. I further consent to and authorize the Releasees to publish my/my child's image, likeness and information in any medium, including but not limited to photographs, videos, DVDs, and web-casts. I understand that this publication will take place in the public domain, including in printed materials, public announcements, and on the internet.
